The Department of Pathology at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine seeks a full-time non-tenure-eligible Clinician-Educator at the rank of Assistant, Associate, or Professor. Responsibilities include clinical service in Genitourinary and General Surgical Pathology Services with the possibility of including other areas dependent on applicant. The division evaluates over 6,000 in-house and second opinion consult cases annually. Both the Urology department and the Lurie Cancer Center are outstanding and serve as centers for academic activity in urologic research. Faculty are expected to participate in the teaching and mentoring of residents, fellows, and occasionally medical students, as well as to serve on department, university, and/or hospital-based committees.

Qualified candidates will hold MD or MD/PhD degrees and be board certified in AP or AP/CP from the American Board of Pathology, as well as be eligible for an unrestricted medical license in the State of Illinois. Fellowship training in GU and general surgical pathology is required; additional fellowship training or experience in other surgical pathology subspecialty areas would be viewed favorably.

The start date is negotiable, and the position will remain open until filled. Rank and remuneration determined by qualifications and experience.
