This full-time, continuing position carries a primary faculty appointment at the Feinberg School of Medicine, Northwestern University, at a rank commensurate with experience and academic activity. Primary responsibilities include scientific and clinical leadership over the Clinical Chemistry Laboratory. Scope may include oversight of other laboratories using similar testing platforms, as needed.

Qualified candidates will be certified or eligible for certification by the American Board of Pathology in Clinical Pathology or by the American Board of Clinical Chemistry or equivalent. At least 2 years of experience as a CLIA laboratory director preferred and participation in the leadership of other clinical laboratory sections (e.g., immunology, coagulation) is encouraged.
