In addition to the general requirements for faculty appointments and ranking, responsibilities include:

- Medical oversight of pre-transfusion compatibility testing and transfusion safety for FDA-registered transfusion service
- Guidance of proper blood use and patient blood management practices
- Transfusion medicine consultations including immunohematological problems and transfusion adverse events
- Program director of ACGME-accredited Blood Bank/Transfusion Medicine fellowship in McGaw Medical Center of Northwestern University
- Assistance in medical coverage for NMH Hemostasis Laboratory and Lurie Children's Hospital transfusion service

Qualified candidates will hold MD or MD/PhD degrees; be board certified in CP or AP/CP from the American Board of Pathology; and be board certified in Transfusion Medicine by the American Board of Pathology. Candidates must be eligible for an unrestricted medical license in the State of Illinois. Rank and remuneration determined by qualifications and experience.
